This private sector-led initiative, in collaboration with the United Nations, civil society, academia and other stakeholders, is leveraging human capital investments through employee volunteer programs globally to advance the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The SDGs are focused on addressing the most critical issues in the world, including poverty, inequality and climate change. The objective of IMPACT 2030 is to align companies and their employee volunteer efforts with these global goals to create real and sustainable change.

IMPACT 2030 was created in response to UN Resolution A/RES/66/67 that encouraged further engagement with the private sector *“through the expansion of corporate volunteering and employee volunteer activities”*. The IMPACT 2030 coalition convenes leaders from corporations, the United Nations, civil society, academia, and philanthropic organizations. Each IMPACT 2030 partner company has committed to applying its employee volunteer actions towards one or more of the SDGs.

At the end of 15 years, we will leave existing and new organizations with advanced tools to engage employees in volunteer work, measure impact of volunteer efforts, and promote the power of employee volunteers to change the world.
